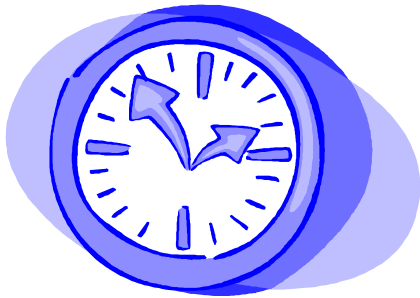


Membership Information
